Paper 1

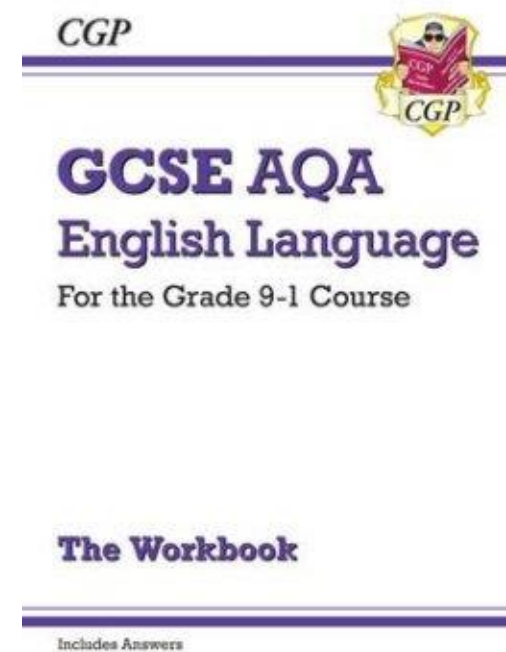
- 1) Will ask you to list 4 things
- 2) Will ask you to analyse language
- 3) Will ask you to analyse structure
- 4) Will ask for an evaluation

- 5) Will ask you to write a description or a story

Paper 2

- 1) Will ask you to choose 4 things from a list
- 2) Will ask for a comparative summary between two texts
- 3) Will ask you to analyse language
- 4) Will ask for an analytical comparison of two texts

- 5) Will ask you to write a piece of non-fiction in a given form



Students will get a revision workbook and be set regular tasks from this.

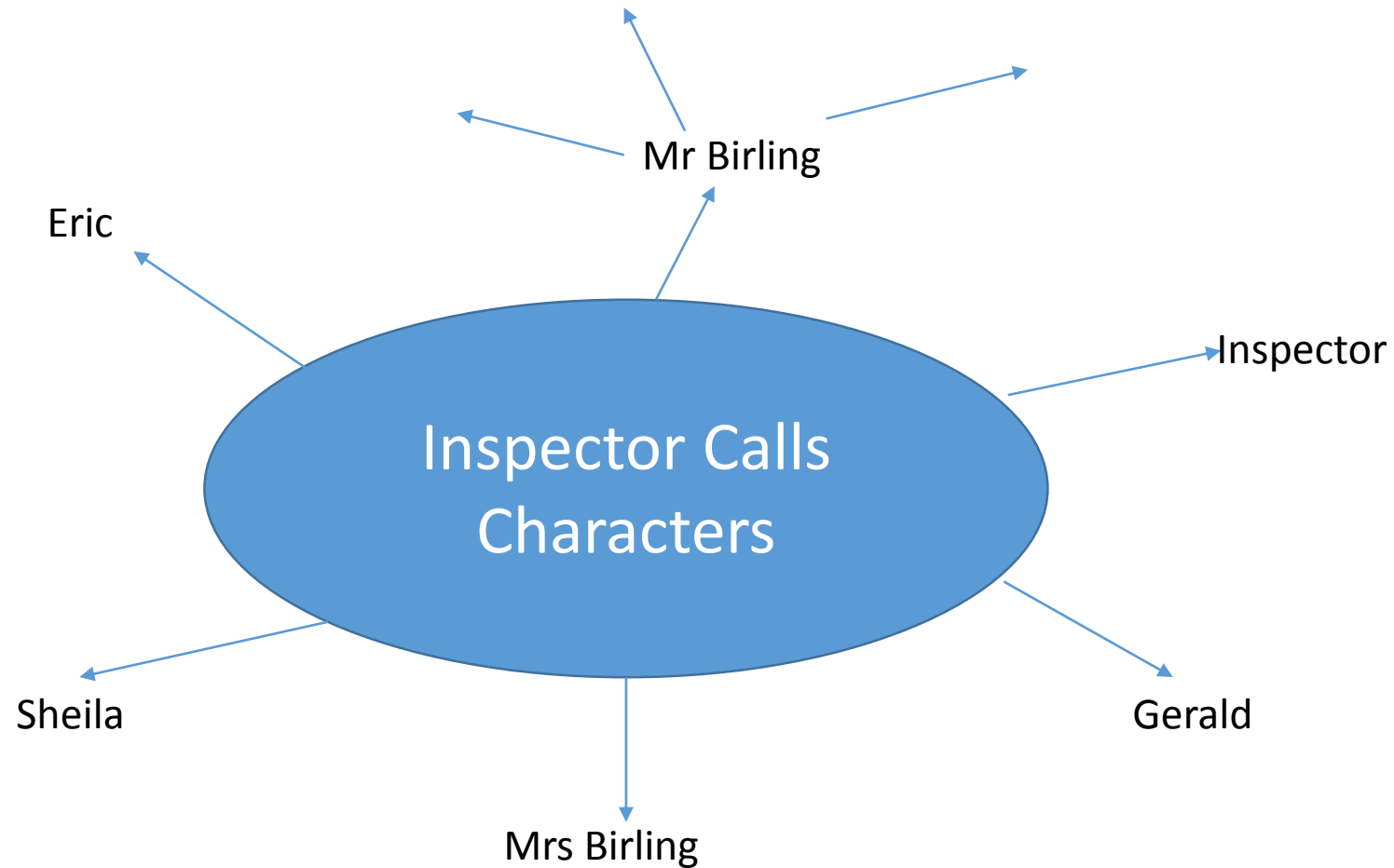
Online:
