Ethics Cup

Yesterday 8 of our wonderful students competed in the Ethics Cup, hosted at the University of Leeds by the School of Philosophy and Ethics. Students engaged in several case studies with some key ethical and philosophical debates at their centre. Examples of the moral questions being discussed included 'Should we pierce babies' ears? to 'Were the Covid-19 medical trials ethical?' Students competed in a series of head-to-head matches with another schools, where they presented their cases and were judged by a panel of highly acclaimed academics from the world of ethics and philosophy. The students were then asked questions by the judges and were graded on their presentation, response to questions, and the questions they asked the other team. Lawnswood team's presentations were outstanding, they spoke









with confidence and the judges remarked repeatedly on their eloquence, maturity and thoughtful response to these ethical questions. The Lawnswood Ethics Cup Team were a credit to our school community and achieved sixth place in their points count. They missed the semi-finals by a whisper and the teams that made it through were Sixth Form students compared to our Year 10 and 11 students. We are immensely proud of our Ethics Cup Team.

Year 9 Options process

This half term we start the exciting process of supporting our Year 9 students to choose which subjects to study in Year 10.

We deliberately afford the students several weeks to make the decision as it can be a difficult and important one. The process will begin next week, when students will watch a video in tutor period which explains the process.

The launch proper then takes place at options evening on Tuesday 23 January, 5.30-7.00pm. If your child is in Year 9, please ensure that you can come along, with them, to this event.

Students will be shown how to login to the online options system as well as the different subjects available to them. We find that this process is most successful when students take time to talk to their teachers, family and friends, so I would like to offer my thanks in advance for your engagement in the process.

Year 10 & Year 12 Target Setting

We take target setting at GCSE and A Level very seriously and feel strongly that it is only valuable if the targets set are driven by the students themselves and based upon a wealth of evidence. During this half term the Year 10 and Year 12 students will be supported by their class teachers to set meaningful targets. More information about this will be provided to you next week, alongside a video explanation of how the process works and how best to support your child to set meaningful, ambitious and motivational targets for them.
