Entry Requirements

To study Music at A level you will need at least a grade 5 at GCSE.

Knowledge & Skills gained:

A Level Music provides the opportunity for students to acquire advanced musical skills, knowledge and understanding through listening and analysis, composing and performing. It encourages students to build on the knowledge and experience gained at GCSE and in their musical activities outside the curriculum.

Students will extend their knowledge and understanding of musical language, styles and genres. They will gain a good foundation for studying Music in higher education or for pursuing other careers in the music industry, and will develop a range of personal qualities including self-confidence, communication and team-working skills, and analytical, technological and evaluation skills.



Future Opportunities

University - Students studying A Level Music often go on to study Music and other Performing Arts related subjects at university.

Employment opportunities – A Level Music is a highly regarded qualification by employers in the music and other multimedia industries.
