Lawnswood Roundabout Scheme – update

In area 9C (outside Weetwood Hall) we have installed the traffic signal columns and completed all the kerbing in this area. The drainage works are ongoing.

In phase 4 (outside Lawnswood School) while carrying out drainage installation we found two unknown gas mains, which now they have been investigated were found to be redundant so we can remove these. During this short pause we pressed on with kerbing works in this area.

In Phase 7 (by the Police station / sub-station) we are preparing for the widening and installing the kerbs here. Site clearance further north has commenced.

In phase 6 Yorkshire Water have completed their diversion works as well. This means we can commence our works in this area shortly, whilst liaising with residents to minimise disruption.

In phase 9b the footway kerbing has been installed, and we have started stripping off the old tarmac in this area where the old bus stop was, prior to installation of the new binder course.
