They must also be made to the school in advance, as the Department for Education has told schools that they cannot authorise any absences after they have been taken.						
Fines I understand that if my request is unauthorised I am most likely to be fined, £60 per parent, £60 per child (for example a family of 4 with 2 parents and 2 children will be fined a total of £240).						
Once the penalty notice is issued, I have 21 days in which to pay the fine. If I fail to pay in that period, the fine will double and I then have another seven days in which to pay, taking the total time in which to make payment to 28 days.
