EPR is delivered to every class in Key Stage 3 and is a popular choice for students in Key Stages 4. This is in part due to our excellent results – last year 70% of our GCSE students met or beat their target grade, with 75% of students achieving grade 5 or higher.

In EPR, our focus is to enthuse and excite students in lessons so that they feel comfortable and confident to excel. We accommodate all learning styles with engaging and challenging activities.

We investigate philosophical questions from a range of different views, such as 'What has EPR got to do with me?', 'How do we make a successful community?' and 'What makes a good leader?'

We promote an enquiring, critical and sympathetic approach to the study of ethics, philosophy and religion as well as nurturing a sense of self-esteem within the students, developing a positive attitude towards themselves, their peers and their work.
