Entry Requirements

At least grade 4 in GCSE Textiles, Design Technology and/or GCSE Art.

Knowledge & Skills gained:

You will gain knowledge, skills, and enjoyment studying the following:

- Learn the basic elements of textiles, fashion and art and design
- Improve your skills in sewing, surface pattern, embroidery, painting, printing, constructing textiles, felting, weaving and fabric manipulation.
- You will also learn how to progress your studies from initial ideas through to final outcomes and how to present those outcomes to achieve their maximum visual impact.

A level Textiles provides students with opportunities to develop personal responses to ideas, observations, experiences, environments and cultures in practical, critical and contextual forms.

Complementary Subjects

There are no requirements to study Textiles along with other specific subjects, but many of our students also take other creative subjects such as Art, Photography or Graphic Design.



Future Opportunities

A Levels provide an excellent basis for progression to higher level qualifications such as Costume, Fashion or Interior degrees. Textiles can provide skills which can be used in a wide range of occupations including Fashion Design. Colourist, Merchandising, Stylist, Buyer, Costume Design (Stage, Film and TV), Interior Design (Domestic or Contract), Printed Textiles, Woven Textiles, Embroidered Textiles, Surface Pattern, Gallery Work, Exhibition Organiser.
