Entry Requirements

You are expected to have at least a grade 4 in English and / or maths and a level 2 qualification in the subject area is desirable (science or health and social care).



Knowledge & Skills Gained

The course aims to develop skills such as communication and confidence in a variety of situations, that will support the student in practical health and social care settings. It will also allow learners to build excellent interpersonal skills, and an understanding of how to deliver person-centred care.

The course is designed to cover a variety of topics that prepare students to work in Health and Social Care/ NHS careers in a professional capacity.

Future Opportunities

Nursing (Diploma or Degree) - all branches (adults, sick children, mental health, midwifery and learning disabilities).

Students can also progress on to other health related degree courses i.e. Radiography, Occupational therapy, Physiotherapy, Health studies, Health promotion etc.

A variety of health care settings will employ Level 3 qualified individuals; these include hospitals, clinics, residential homes and a variety of voluntary agencies.
